## What is P.Y.S.E.?

What is Preparing Your Spiritual Environment all about and what does it mean to believers in the body of Christ?

- ❖ *P.Y.S.E. is a process believers utilize to establish protection, by taking God's given authority to bind and rebuke unwarranted attacks from spiritual adversaries (the kingdom of darkness), then further defining the limits and boundaries to keep the enemy at bay, by utilizing an offensive prayer personalized for the believer.*

# Authority of the Believer

Let's examine our God given authority according to **Luke 10:19**.

❖ Behold, I give unto you **power** to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you

I give unto YOU **Power (G1849 Exousia)** **power of authority**

## Unwarranted attacks

As we begin to use our God given authority, Jesus reminds us that our adversary the devil will try to attack us. Let's read **1 Peter 5:6-9**.

**v6** Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time:

**v7** Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.

**v8** Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:

**v9** Whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.

# Authority of the Believer

Let's break down some words to understand our adversary and our authority

1 Peter 5:6-9

v7 Care (G3308 merimna) through the idea of distractions, anxiety

v7 Care root meaning (G3307 merizo) to separate into parts, cut into pieces, to divide into parties i.e. to be split into factions

v8 Be sober (G3525 nepho) to be sober, to be calm and collected in spirit, to be temperate, dispassionate, circumspect, be discreet, watch

v8 Be vigilant (G1127 gregoreuo) to watch, give strict attention, be cautious, be active, take heed lest through some destructive calamity suddenly overtake you

**These are responsibilities for ALL believers!**

# **P.Y.S.E. Prayer Verbiage**

Based on what we've just learned, lets start by introducing some statements that you would include while building your PYSE prayer.

Remember, your PYSE prayer will be used to bind and rebuke unwarranted attacks from the kingdom of darkness, and define the limits and boundaries to keep the enemy at bay.

Here is some verbiage to fit into your prayer:

- ❖ Lord, thank you for giving us the power to tread on serpents and scorpions and over all the power of the enemy lest none shall hurt us
- ❖ Thank you for giving us your God given authority to overcome the enemy and prevent being attacked. We are sober and vigilant for we know that our adversary the devil roams about like a roaring lion, seeking who he can devour

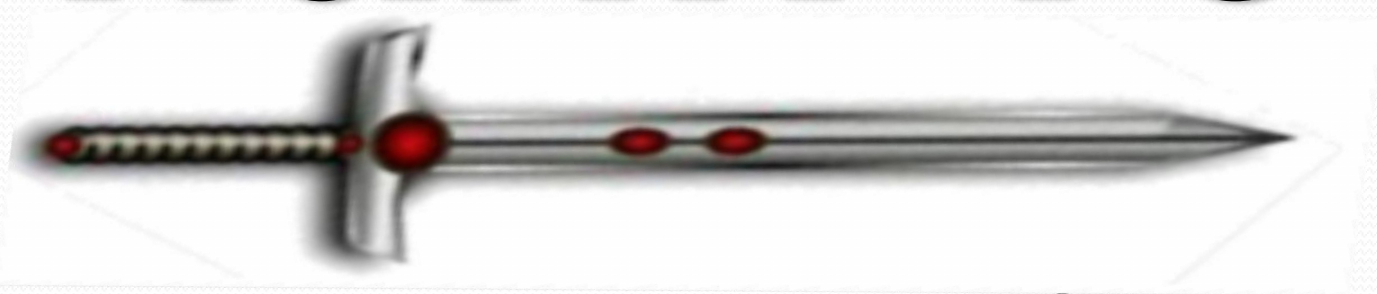
