Prayer fundamentals

The anatomy of a prayer is a structured format, or outline if you will, that guides a believer in constructing an effective prayer with scripture through acknowledgment, warfare, and blessing and/or praise. This creates a very powerful combination of weaponry against the enemy.

- 1) **Acknowledgement** – the opening petition prayer to Jesus enables the believer to acknowledge what God has given **HIS** children concerning power and authority from **HIS WORD** over the enemy. In this case, you are acknowledging Jesus for what he has given you to combat the enemy, and thanking **HIM** for it
- 2) **Warfare** – Believers are to tailor their prayers with the **WORD** concerning their specific spiritual condition. Nothing is more effective than to interject with authority, specific scriptures into your prayer to drive the enemy away.
 - ❖ Always announce your authority to the enemy. Without exertion of authority using **God's WORD**, the enemy will continue to assault
- 3) **Blessing and/or Praise** – The closing section should be tailored in a variety of expressions. For example, you can make decrees such as thanking Jesus for the power and authority **HE** has given you. If you are praying for a person or others that have come against you, you can bless them. People generally receive curses rather than blessings. Blessing others is a powerful spiritual weapon to back off the enemy and hinder them greatly.

Opening petition prayer

Let's examine the "**Opening petition prayer**" from the **P.Y.S.E.** brochure and see why specific scriptures were inserted.

Opening petition prayer to Jesus: Establishing your God given Authority!

Lord, I know you have given me (**Exousia**) power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt me (**Luke 10:19**).

➤ **Luke 10:19** was inserted to acknowledge the power we have over demons. Jesus has given us the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever I shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever I shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven (**Matt 16:19**).

➤ **Matt 16:19** acknowledges that we can bind demons and loose angels. Lord, thank you for this authority. Holy Spirit, I ask for you to give me revelation (**John 14:26**), and wisdom (**James 1:5**) to conquer and be victorious (**1 Cor 15:57**).

➤ **John 14:26** reveals that the Holy Spirit gives us revelation

➤ **James 1:5** tells us that we can ask for Wisdom

➤ **1 Cor 15:57** states that we can conquer and be victorious

Get creative, review examples to insert into the "**Opening petition prayer**"!

- ❖ **Eph 2:6** HE has raised us to sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus
- ❖ **Isaiah 54:17** No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn

Warfare prayer

Let's examine the "**Warfare prayer**" from the **P.Y.S.E.** brochure and see what specific warfare scriptures were inserted.

Announcing your authority to the kingdom of darkness!

When engaging the enemy in warfare, make your presence known to the enemy and who you represent.

❖ **Phil 2:9-10** declares that you have authority in these locations

Using the BLOODLINE and establishing perimeters of protection!

Place the blood of Jesus around all that you have and own. The Bloodline is our first defense because Jesus shed HIS blood and paid for us in full.

❖ **Matt 26:28** reminds us that HIS blood was shed for remission of sin

❖ **Job 1:10** reveals God's HEDGE of protection

Exert your Authority NOW with the Sword of the Spirit and bind spirits!

We must put a stop and/or severely hinder the enemy from unwarranted attacks.

❖ **Matt 16:19** gives us authority to bind demons and loose angels

❖ **Mark 1:25** shows us how Jesus rebuked the spirit and cast it out

Everything under Satan's influence, domain, and control!

You are now decreeing to all the enemy camps working against you, and breaking the attacks from people and curses with God's Sword!

❖ **Eph 6:17** confirms the Sword of the Spirit breaks the enemy's weapons against you

Closing prayer

Let's examine the "**Closing prayer**" from the **P.Y.S.E.** brochure and see why specific scriptures were inserted.

Closing prayer: Now turn to Jesus and give Him Praise!

I Thank You Lord, for giving me power to tread upon serpents and scorpions and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing by any means will hurt me (**Luke 10:19**). What I have spoken in the spiritual realm I now consider it in effect (**Gen 1:3, 6, 9, 11, etc./Matt 21:19-22**). In Jesus Mighty Name, Amen!

- **Luke 10:19** thanks the Lord for giving us that authority
- **Gen 1:3, 6, 9, 11** we should thank HIM for what we have spoken. It is in effect because we have the authority to speak and create as HE did in the beginning
- **Matt 21:19-22** reveals that we can speak and create just as Jesus did in this verse when he cursed the fig tree

Get creative, review examples that we can insert into the "**Closing prayer**"!

- ❖ **Matt 5:44** always bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you
