Prayer Facts

When in prayer, always ask the Holy Spirit for revelation.

John 14:26 About the **Comforter**, which is the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, <u>he shall teach you all things</u>, and bring all things to your <u>remembrance</u>, whatsoever I have said unto you.

Comforter (G3875 parakletos) an intercessor, consoler:--Advocate, comforter

When praying for someone and when possible, always try to get the person's name and ask permission for you to pray and intercede on their behalf; *Why?* When Opening and Closing prayers, always apply scripture when applicable.

The WORD weakens the enemy

For Warfare Prayers, always apply the weapons of warfare from scripture.

For example: The Bloodline, the Sword of the Spirit (Eph 6:12), Bind & Loose them (Matt 16:19), Command them (Mark 1:25), etc.

Also, call by name every spirit, sickness, curse, etc., that you know!

Prayer Facts

Ask the Holy Spirit for discernment to help us know our environments and what kind of spirits are around you.

What Warfare Prayer Is Not

Warfare Prayer is not petitioning God

It is pointless to petition God for help when he has already given us the <u>POWER</u> to use HIS name!

Warfare Prayer is not begging God in prayer

Begging God is also pointless because HE is expecting YOU to stand up and fight your own battles!

<u>Warfare Prayer is not</u> about flooding heaven with prayers when HE has already given you the authority!

You are to exert your authority directly to the enemy!

Warfare Prayer is not fighting the enemy physically

- This is a fallacy according to Eph 6:12 & 2 Cor 10:3-4, as it <u>clearly states</u> that we wrestle NOT with flesh & blood!
- Eph 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood
- ❖ 2 Cor 10:3-4 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: v4 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds

What Warfare Prayer Is Not

Warfare Prayer is not praying and expecting the Lord to get the enemy off of YOU!

- HE has already defeated Satan at the <u>CROSS!</u>
- Jesus has NOW given us the <u>POWER</u> and the <u>Responsibility</u> to overcome the enemy!

<u>Warfare Prayer is not</u> a distorted, assumed understanding of scripture; this is called error!

- For this reason so many prayers are unanswered!
- Learn the weapons of warfare from scripture, and formulate your plan of attack with precision
- Your enemy will be more cautious when he knows you can target your attacks on him, and destroy his effects!

Warfare Prayer Verbiage

Based on what we've just learned, let's start by introducing some statements that you would include while building warfare prayer.

Remember, your warfare prayer will be used to bind and rebuke unwarranted attacks from the kingdom of darkness.

Here is some verbiage to fit into your prayer:

- ❖ Lord, according to John 14:26, I ask for revelation so I can intercede on behalf of this person
- ❖ You have given me the power to overcome the enemy according to Luke 10:19 because you defeated him at the cross
- ❖ In the name of Jesus, I remit the sins of this person because John 20:23 says that whosoever sins I remit, they are remitted unto him
- ❖ In the name of Jesus, I command this X spirit to come out of this person and go to the feet of Jesus now
