Origin of Soul Ties

In the beginning, God's original purpose was to form relationships with his people, through fellowship by the spirit and the soul, to become one with HIM.

Gen 1:27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

v28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it.

*In these passages we see the first signs of human and physical interactions which developed bonding relationships, i.e. **Soul Ties**.*

Now let's take a look at the soul that God formed!

Gen 2:7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

Breath (H5397 neshamah) a puff, wind, vital breath, divine inspiration, intellect, soul, spirit.

Breathed (H5301 naphach) to inflate, blow hard, scatter, kindle.

Origin of Soul Ties, cont'd

Soul (H5315 nephesh) a breathing creature, vitality.

Soul root (H5314 naphash) to breathe, passively, to be breathed upon, to be refreshed as if by a current of air.

We see that the Lord created the Soul for men and women.

Now we will see what condition the Lord set for the offspring.

Gen 2:22 And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man.

v23 And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.

v24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.

The Lord established that the offspring, man, will now cleave to his wife!

Biblical & Modern Terminology

Let's examine the most common Biblical terms that define and share similar definitions concerning **Soul Ties**.

❖ Clave is mentioned 14 times in 14 verses Gen 34:3 - Ruth 1:14 - 1 Kings 11:2

❖ Cleave is mentioned 30 times in 30 verses Gen 2:24 - Deut 4:4 - Josh 22:5

❖ Cleaved is mentioned 3 times in 3 verses 2 Kings 3:3 - Job 29:10 - Job 31:7

OT/Cleave (**H1692 dabaq**) to impinge, cling or adhere, abide, fast, cleave, follow close, be joined (together), keep (fast), overtake, pursue hard, stick, take.

NT/Cleave (**G4347 proskollao**) to glue to, to adhere, cleave, join.

❖ Fellowship is mentioned 17 times in 16 verses

OT/Fellowship (**H2266 chabar**) to join, to fascinate, be compact, couple together, have fellowship with, heap up, join (self-together), league.

NT/Fellowship (**G2842 koinonia**) partnership, participation or social intercourse, primary benediction, communication, communion, distribution, fellowship.

❖ Knit is mentioned 6 times in 6 verses

OT/Knit (**H2270 chaber**) an associate, companion, fellow, knit together.

NT/Knit (**G4822 sumbibazo**) to drive together, unite in association or affection, to infer, show, teach, compact, assuredly, gather, instruct, knit together, prove.

Biblical & Modern Terminology, cont'd

Joined is mentioned 43 times in 42 verses.

OT/Joined has 9 word variations which have common meaning. One example is found in Psalms.

Psalms 106:28 They joined themselves also unto Baalpeor, and ate the sacrifices of the dead.

Joined (**H6775 tsamad**) means to link, i.e. gird, to serve, contrive, fasten, frame, join (self).

NT/Joined has 6 word variations which have common meaning. Two examples are found in 1 Cor.

1 Cor 6:16-17 What? know ye not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, saith he, shall be one flesh. But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit.

Joined (**G2853 kollao**) means to glue, to stick, cleave, join (self), keep company.

The most common meaning for all of these Biblical terms is the word Joined or Joined Together. There are a Total of 103 references to Soul Ties.

We can see so much emphasis on Soul Ties to validate they are real.

Biblical & Modern Terminology, cont'd

Let's examine other Modern titles used by Christendom for the term **Soul Ties**.

Bosom Buddies	Committed Relationships	Demonic Unions
Evil/Demonic Ties	One Flesh Unions	Soul Mate
Unholy Alliances	Unholy Covenants	Unholy Ties
