The Spirit, Soul, and Body

We are going to examine how the three parts of our being, the **spirit** and the **soul** and the **body**, were made to function by God in order to have fellowship with HIM to form Godly Soul Ties.

Let's take a look at scripture references on the spirit, soul, and body.

1 Thes 5:23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole <u>spirit</u> and <u>soul</u> and <u>body</u> be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.


Heb 4:12 For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of <u>soul</u> and <u>spirit</u>, and of the <u>joints and marrow</u>, and is a discerner of the <u>thoughts</u> and <u>intents</u> of the <u>heart</u>.

3 John 1:2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

Why did John wish that the flesh and the soul prosper above all?

❖ The spirit receives Salvation, but the soul and the flesh are a struggle

The Spirit, Soul, & Body Illustrated



The mind is an incredible organ but is bound by the body (flesh) to the sin of this world, but still God allows us to pass from the physical to the spiritual dimensions to know both realms from the tree of good and evil.


The soul is a very interactive component with the spirit and the body/mind. It provides people with emotions, consciousness, will, mind, breath of life, desires, affections; an essence which differs from the body and not dissolved by death.

The soul is sought after by Satan who wants to steal our very essence, our breath of life received from God.

The human spirit is where God resides when we receive salvation. Without God, people live separated from HIM.

Our spirit also receives revelation, life eternal, comfort, the life force, inner self, personality, and character.

The Spirit



John 7:38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water

Romans 10:10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation

John 14:26 But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in Jesus name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you


John 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life

Job 10:12 Thou hast granted me life and favour, and thy visitation hath preserved my spirit

Psalms 31:5 Into thine hand I commit my spirit: thou hast redeemed me, O LORD God of truth

Isaiah 38:16 O Lord, by these things men live, and in all these things is the life of my spirit: so wilt thou recover me, and make me to live

The Soul



Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of <u>soul and spirit</u>, and of the <u>joints and marrow</u>, and is <u>a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart</u>

Dividing asunder (G3311) a separation or distribution


Matthew 22:37 Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind

Genesis 2:7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul

Deuteronomy 4:29 But if from thence thou shalt seek the LORD thy God, thou shalt find him, if thou seek him with all thy heart and with all thy soul

Psalms 49:15 But God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave: for he shall receive me. Selah

The Body



The mind is characterized as the flesh (part of the human body) as it is referenced in scripture as carnal. The mind holds in its power the key to making right and wrong decisions between good and evil

Romans 7:25 I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin NOTE: The mind can be feeble to proper decision making. Paul is talking about choosing (making the right choice) for God or for sin

Romans 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit NOTE: Again, believers have to make the proper choice


Romans 8:5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit

Romans 8:7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be

NOTE: The carnal mind (produces sin) is God's enemy

Romans 8:8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God NOTE: When we sin we open the door to the enemy to come in

The Cyclic Cycle of Sin Illustrated



Eph 6:16 ye shall be able to quench all the **fiery darts** of the wicked.

The cyclical sin process consists of **fiery darts** sent to the believer's mind where it makes the decision to operate in good or in sin. If a decision is to sin, the thought is communicated from the <u>mind</u> to the <u>soul</u>, and the soul acts out that decision. This creates an agreement that opens the door for the enemy to gain a legal right. As long as a person operates in this cyclic cycle of deception, they will stay bound.

Concerning sin, the soul becomes the arbitrator which decides what to do when sin is contemplated by the mind.

Mat 5:28 But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.

When our spirit receives salvation the Holy Spirit starts communicating with us. It is directing believers to operate in truth and providing discernment to guide our spiritual walk. NOTE: when believers are in a cyclic cycle of sin, the spirit's voice can be severely hindered
