Godly Soul Ties in Scripture

Let's examine some <u>Good</u> Soul Ties from a scriptural perspective concerning the bond Jacob had with his child Benjamin.


Gen 44:20 And we said unto my lord, We have a father, an old man, and a child of his old age, a little one; and his brother is dead, and he alone is left of his mother, and his father loveth him.

Gen 44:21 And thou saidst unto thy servants, Bring him down unto me, that I may set mine eyes upon him.

Gen 44:22 And we said unto my lord, The lad cannot leave his father: for if he should leave his father, his father would die.

Now let's review some Soul Ties concerning David and Jonathan.

1 Sam 18:1 Now when he had finished speaking to Saul, the soul of Jonathan was knit to the soul of David, and Jonathan loved him as his own soul.



Ungodly Soul Ties in Scripture

Let's see what Shechem did to Jacob's daughter, Dinah.

Gen 34:2 And when Shechem, the son of Hamor the Hivite, prince of the country, saw her, he took her, and lay with her, and defiled her.


Gen 34:3 And his soul clave unto Dinah the daughter of Jacob, and he loved the damsel, and spake kindly unto the damsel.

In this story, Shechem forced himself onto Dinah against her own will.

Let's consider how King Saul developed a soul tie of jealousy against David.

1 Sam 18:8 And Saul was <u>very wroth</u>, and the saying displeased him; and he said, They have ascribed unto David ten thousands, and to me they have ascribed but thousands: and what can he have more but the kingdom?

1 Sam 18:11 And Saul cast the javelin; for he said, <u>I will smite David even to the wall with it.</u> And David avoided out of his presence twice.



Severing Ties With Loved Ones

We are aware of the sensitivity and hesitancy some believers may have when it comes to severing ties with loved ones or anyone else. Let's clarify some of these misunderstandings.

Severing soul ties with loved ones DOES NOT:

- Sever your relationships with infants, children or other family members with whom a negative tie is identified
- Separate or distance yourself from your relationships with anyone
- Nor will it come against or violate any person's will

What severing soul ties with loved ones **DOES**:

- ❖ It severs the unholy or demonic ties that have developed during a negative encounter with your loved ones in verbal, physical, or sexual experiences
- ❖ By severing ties it <u>removes legal rights</u> from demonic forces that come against you with spiritual attacks
